A). Service to Church

Applicant has been an active member of their church community through participation in church services or religious education programs.

We are interested in the type of activity, the commitment to the activity, and approximate number of years (time invested) in their service to the church.

B). Community Service

We are interested in the type of activity, the commitment to the activity, and approximate number of hours (time invested) in their service. We are also interested in any awards or significant honors the applicant has gained from community service (i.e. Gold Award, Eagle Scout, State/National Conference attendee etc.)

C). Work Experience

We are interested in the type of experience, the commitment to the activity. This should include time spent working even if applicant was not paid (i.e. working on family farm/business). Consideration should also be given to applicants who are involved in extracurricular activities that may limit their ability to work.

D). Leadership/Extracurricular Experience

The applicant should list the organizational name, years involved, estimate of time commitment. If the applicant assumed a leadership role within that activity and any honors or awards they may have earned in the activity.

E). Essay

Is the essay well-written? Are there grammatical and /or spelling errors? Does the essay address the reasons for receiving the scholarship?
